SHORT BIO: ACADEMIC AND LITERARY PROFILE

Dr. T.T. Sreekumar currently serves as a Professor at the School of Interdisciplinary Studies at the English and Foreign Languages University (EFL University), Hyderabad, where he also holds the position of Director (i/c) of the Educational Multimedia Research Centre (EMRC). His illustrious academic and professional journey includes affiliations with prestigious institutions such as the National University of Singapore, the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology (HKUST), and MICA - The School of Ideas, Ahmedabad.

A bilingual author and editor in English and Malayalam, Dr. Sreekumar has made contributions to both academic and literary fields. His book, *ICTs & Development in India: Perspectives on the Rural Network Society* (Anthem Books, London, 2011), is a seminal work examining the societal impact of information and communication technologies in rural India.

In addition to publishing extensively in national and international academic journals, he has authored or edited over 20 books in Malayalam, covering a wide array of topics including social history, posthumanism, postmodernism, postcolonialism, political thought, and literary criticism.

His research spans multiple countries, including India, Bangladesh, Indonesia, the Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam, and Singapore, and he has presented his findings at major academic conferences across the globe, across continents, including Asia, the USA, Europe, Africa, New Zealand, Canada, and Latin America.

He has held editorial roles such as Editor-in-Chief of the *Journal of Creative Communications* (2013–2017) and Associate Editor of *Media Asia* (2014–2019). Currently, he serves as Editor of the *International Journal of Media Studies* published by EFL University, while also reviewing manuscripts and contributing to editorial advisory boards of esteemed journals.

A prolific writer and columnist in Malayalam, Dr. Sreekumar's literary achievements include over 600 articles and the widely read fortnightly column *Nalaam Kannu* in *Madhyamam Daily*. His work has earned him accolades such as the C.B. Kumar Endowment Award from the Kerala Sahitya Academy in 2021.

With over 600 articles to his name and a widely followed fortnightly column, *Nalaam Kannu*, in *Madhyamam Daily* (Malayalam), he actively engages in contemporary debates and discussions, combining academic rigor with literary perspectives. His multidisciplinary expertise and literary contributions highlight a career marked by both local and global engagement in literature and academic research.
